35th Annual Women's Division Style Show Will Be the Largest Yet

For 34 years the Women's Division of the Mansfield Area Chamber of Commerce has put on a style show to benefit Mansfield Independent School District scholarships and numerous local non-profit organizations. In the last year alone over \$20,000 was given directly back into the community from the Mansfield Women's Division. This year, to celebrate the 35th annual event, the Women's Division is excited to partner with the Mansfield Area Chamber of Commerce, the Mansfield Independent School District and the Mansfield Women's Club to make this fundraising event an even bigger success for the Mansfield community.

"We are honored to partner with so many prestigious local organizations to help raise more funds than we ever have before," said Jenny Conrad, Co-Chair of this year's event. "We look forward to the opportunity to make a difference in our community," she said.

This year's event, "The Streets of Mansfield Style Show and Shopping Expo" will be held on Saturday, September 10th from 10am-8pm at the Tarrant County College SE Campus. The event will feature a style show, a children's showcase style show, a shopping expo with 100 booths, a Taste of Mansfield featuring 30 local restaurants and caterers, a community stage highlighting local talent, a demonstration stage showcasing local businesses and an art show with student artwork. Guests can drop by or spend the day to shop, dine and be entertained. This is the only event of its kind on the south side of the metroplex.

Medi Weightloss Clinic in Arlington is the title sponsor of the Shopping Expo. Each guest will receive a complimentary shopping bag upon entry filled with coupons and a map of booth locations. Guests will have an opportunity to shop 100 booths featuring items like jewelry, fashion accessories, children's clothes, hair bows, art pieces, cooking accessories and much more.

Lady Bugs Boutique and Classy Concepts will provide fashions for the Children's Showcase Style Show and the emcee of the event will be Miss Mansfield. The Women's Division Style Show will feature fashions by Aspirations, Altered Couture and Classy Concepts modeled by the professional models from Page Parks Modeling Agency. Both shows will feature special musical performances as well.

The Community Stage will be a highlight of the event, as it will feature dance groups, gymnastics, cheerleading, karate, musical ensembles, theater groups and more. Kids of all age groups will have an opportunity to perform.

The Demonstration Stage will be another unique feature of the event and will showcase local businesses and their products. Everything from cooking demonstrations to hair and make up demonstrations will take place on this stage.

The Taste of Mansfield will be brought to you by Mansfield Methodist Hospital and will allow guests to sample food from 30 different restaurants and caterers. From desserts to appetizers to main courses guests are sure to leave with full stomachs.

Finally, the Art Show will showcase art from Mansfield Independent School District students of all ages. The artwork will be in the "Streets of Mansfield" theme and the top three pieces of art will be selected for each age level-elementary, middle/junior high and high school. Cash prizes will be awarded to the fine arts department of each of the winning schools.

"The Streets of Mansfield will truly be a community event," said Carrie Ingram Co-Chair of the event. "Local businesses and organizations as well as the children of Mansfield ISD schools will all work together to give back to our community," she said.
